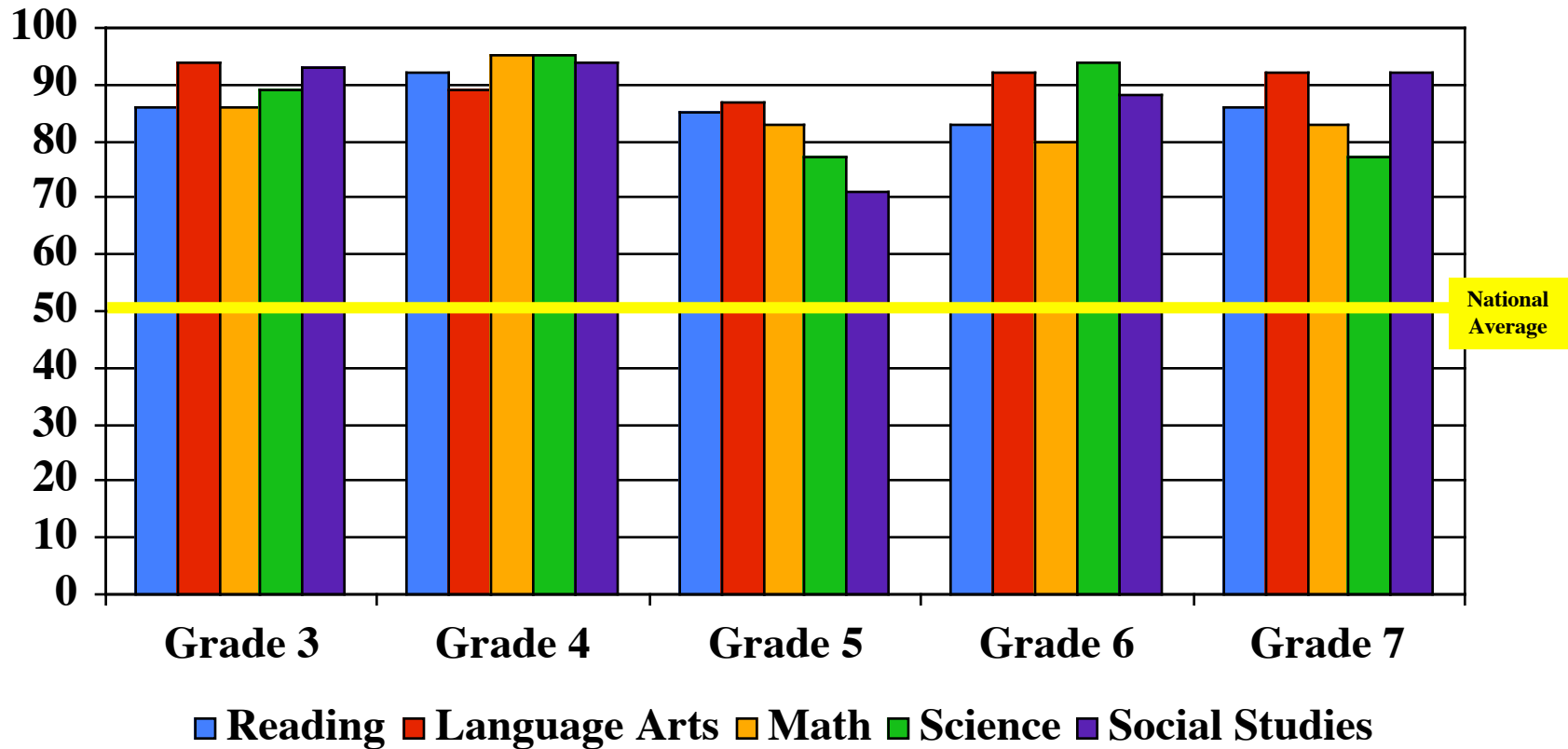
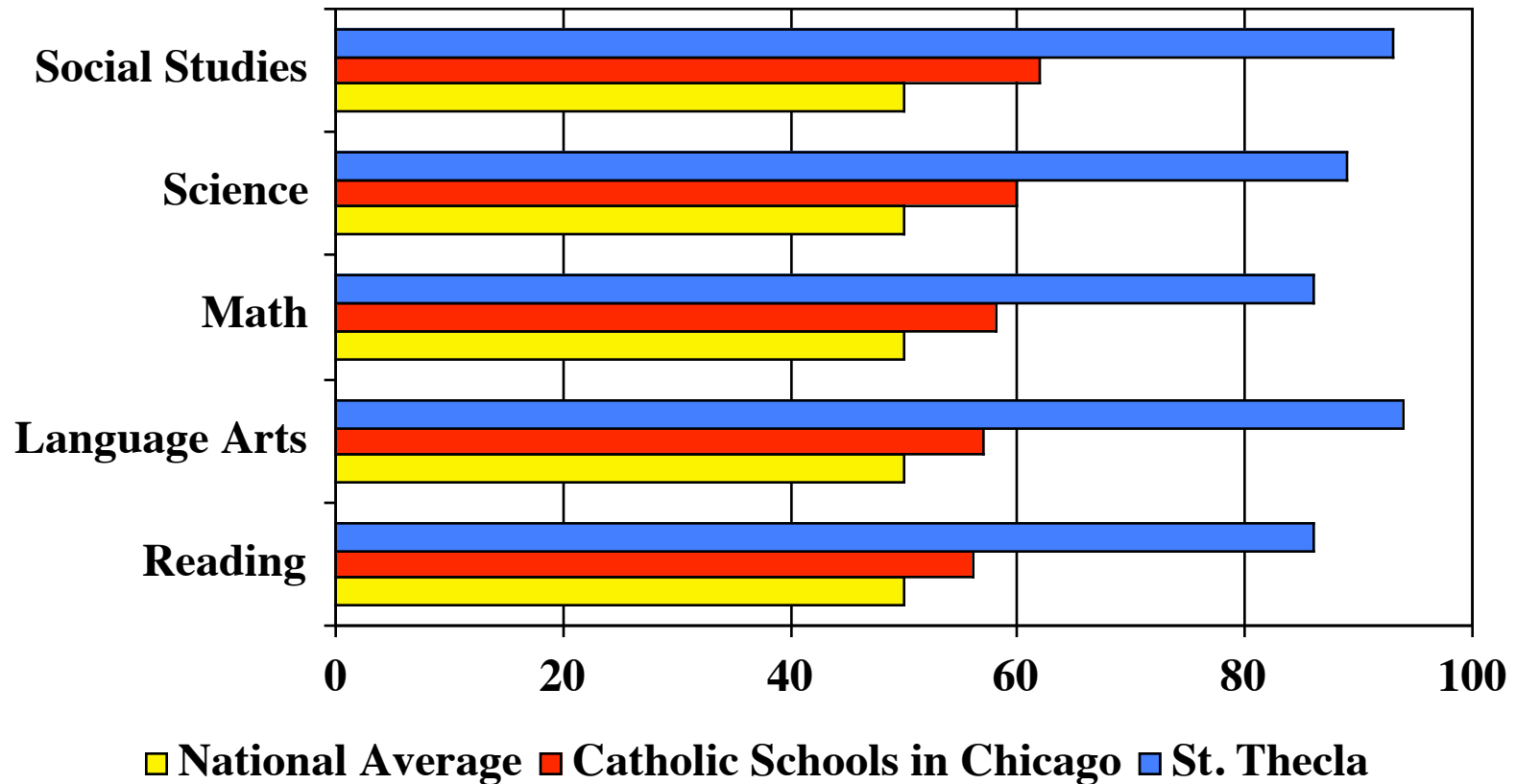


# 2010 St. Thecla Terra Nova National Percentiles



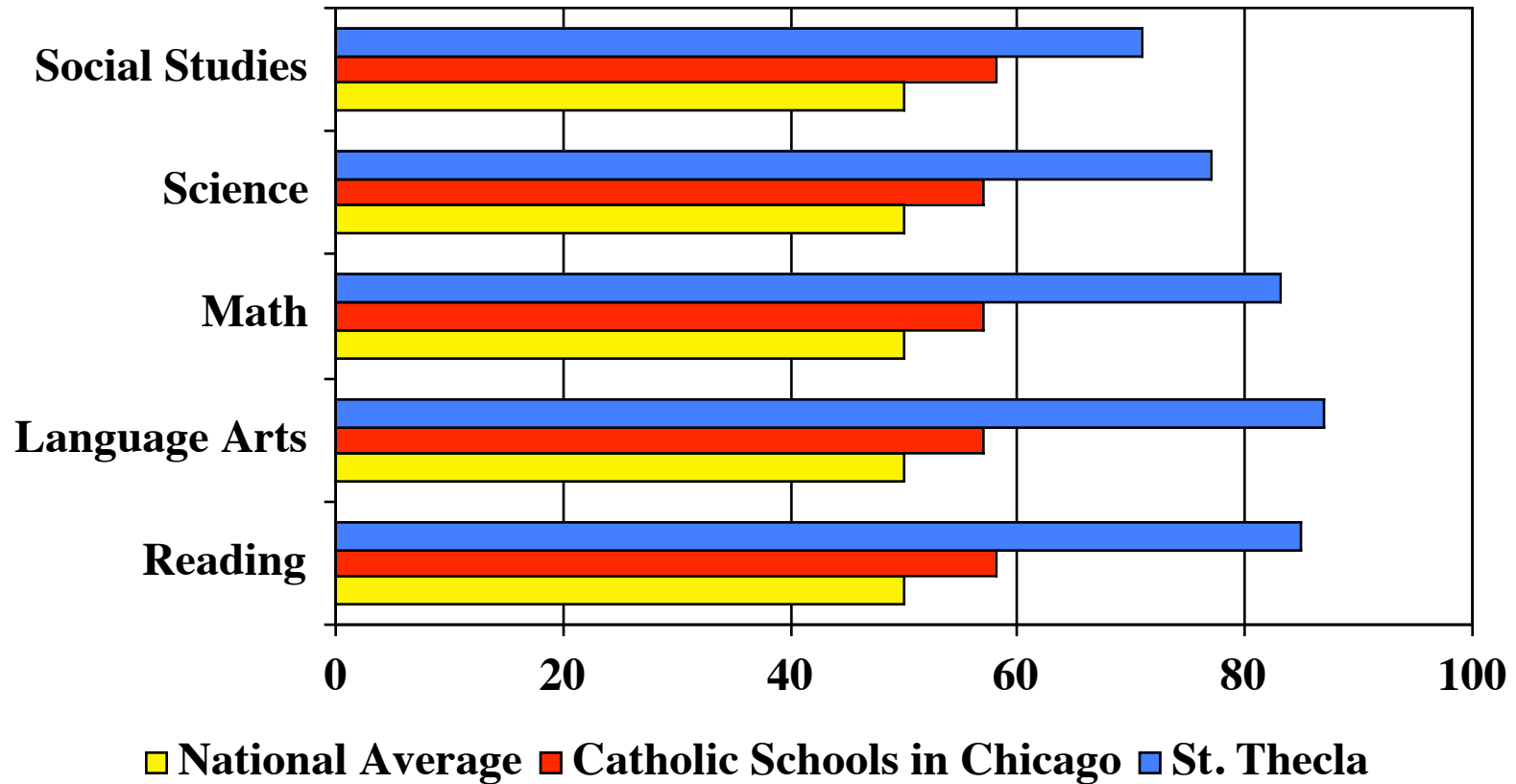
St. Thecla's National Percentiles are the national percentile of the mean normal curve equivalent score. The average student scores at the 50th percentile of the specific grade level assessment. When reading data using national percentiles, one would say that St. Thecla's 3rd grade class scored higher in reading than 86% of the other 3rd graders taking the test nationally; only 14% of students nationally scored higher than St. Thecla's 3rd grade class.

# 2010 St. Thecla Terra Nova 3rd Grade Comparative Data



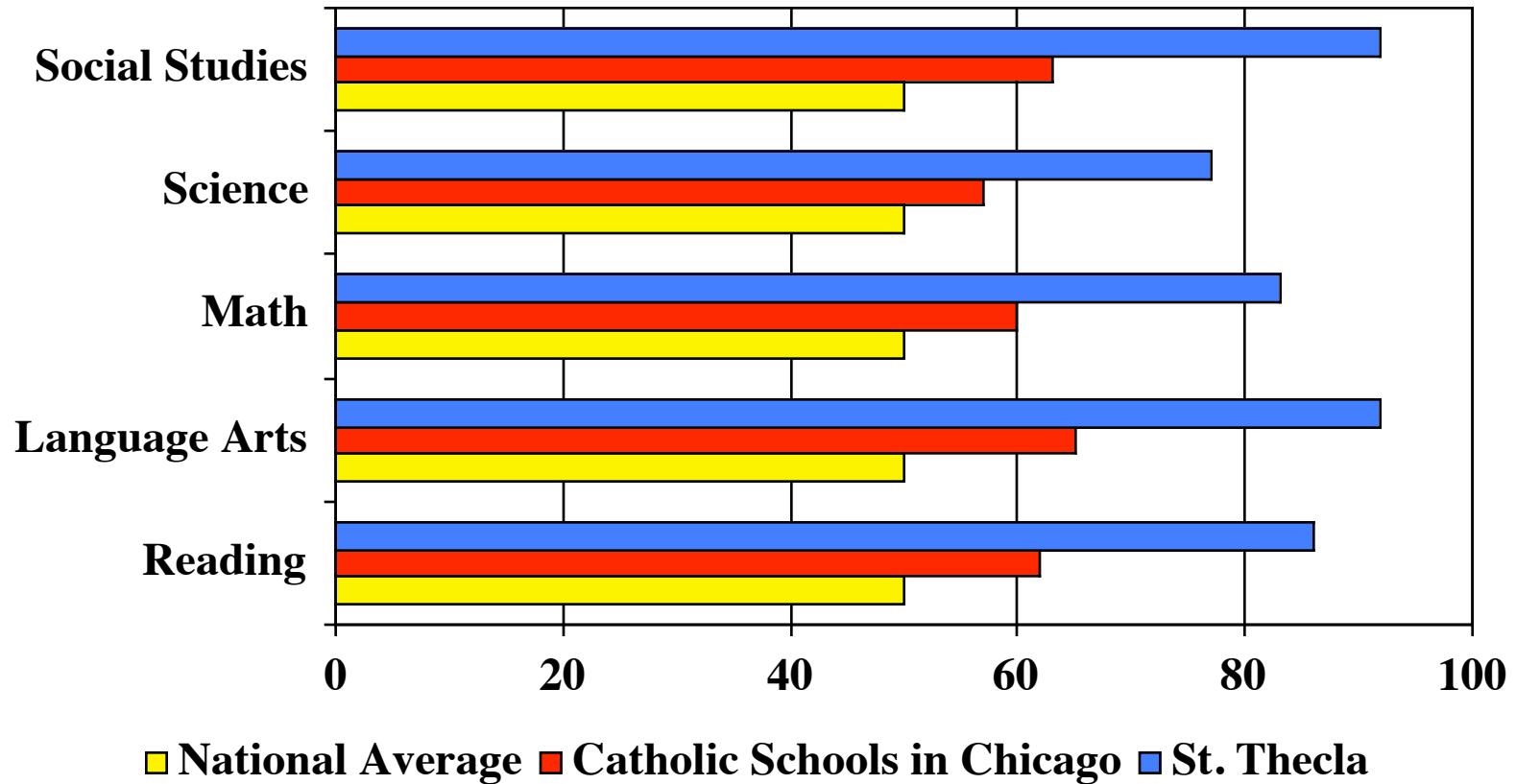
